

BULLETIN 27.5.2023

1. Live tracking during competition

Your glider should be trackable during a competition flight. It is allowed to set the FLARM to stealth-mode reducing the information sent to the tracking service. Tracking links for each class will be published in the competition's WhatsApp group and in SoaringSpot news.

2. How to find my FLARM-ID

We need your FLARM-ID to provide the live tracking service.

1. Take out your glider from the hangar or transport wagon.
2. Power up your FLARM.
3. Go to <https://glideandseek.com/>
4. Wait a few minutes.
5. Locate your glider on the map.
It is a yellow square with either your competition sign or a question mark and the two last numbers of your FLARM-ID (See picture below)
6. When you're sure that the square belongs to your glider, click on the square.
7. A window will appear in the upper right corner containing your FLARM-ID on the second lowest row. (See picture below)
8. Copy the FLARM-ID and send it via WhatsApp to number +358445692220 (Scoring number) in format (comp.sign-FLARM-id)



3. About IGC-files

1. A test file of both flight recorders should be sent to the organisation before 9th of June. We appreciate if you do it as soon as possible.

You can check what information we have of your glider [here](#)
If both FLARM-ID and flight recorder information is correct, you don't have to do anything.
2. We also appreciate if your primary IGC-file delivered to the organisation after a competition task contains same metadata (pilot's name, glider type, glider registration, competition sign) as in the competition entry list. This will help us finding a specific file if the file must be loaded manually into SeeYou.
3. In case of an outlanding, you should strive to send the IGC-file as soon as possible to the scoring service, preferably already from the landing place. This will speed up publishing of the unofficial results.
